Dance Guest Policy

It is the general policy of Dolgeville Central School to keep our dances closed to ensure student and chaperone safety, and provide an atmosphere conducive to good clean fun for our students. However, in an effort to give our students the opportunity and privilege of inviting friends to Dolgeville dances from outside the district, the Board of Education has decided to allow students to bring a guest to the Homecoming Dance, Winter Semi-Formal, Valentine's Day Dance, and Prom under the following conditions:

1. Student guests from outside the district must be under the age of 21.
2. Each Dolgeville student who wishes to invite a guest must complete the district dance guest request form and submit it to the high school office by the Monday prior to the dance.
3. The DCS student is responsible for his/her guest's conduct.
