- The Board directs the Superintendent of Schools to modify the District's reopening plan to reflect that face coverings are not mandated in school settings effective March 2, 2022. All other mitigation measures to minimize the spread of COVID-19 will remain in effect.
- 3. The Board shall continue to make informed decisions on COVID-19 mitigation measures Upon consultation with the County Director of Health.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED.

- Effective July 1, 2022, the Dolgeville Middle School, encompassing grades 5-8, shall be dissolved.
- Effective July 1, 2022, the Dolgeville Elementary School, previously encompassing grades PreK through 4, shall be expanded to encompass grades PreK-6
- Effective July 1, 2022, the Dolgeville James A. Green High School, previously
 encompassing grades 9-12, shall be expanded to encompass grades 7-12 and shall be
 named Dolgeville James A. Green Junior-Senior High School.


